



At RVP, we follow the CDC vaccination administration schedule and guidelines. This schedule is listed below and the age of when the vaccines are administered. All of the vaccines listed are also required for attendance in NYS public schools, Secondary schools (College) & most day care providers unless otherwise stated.

Birth: Hepatitis B

6 wks - 2 months: Pentacel (Dtap, Hib, IPV), Hepatitis B, Rotateq & PCV13

4 months: Pentacel, PCV13 & Rotateq

6 months: Pentacel, Hepatitis B, Rotateq & PCV13

12 months: Varivax, MMR & PCV13

15 months: Pentacel & Hep A (Hep A is not required by school)

2 year: Hep A

4 year: Quadracel (Dtap, IPV) & Proquad (Varivax & MMR)

9 year: Gardasil (not required by school)\*

11 year: Menquadfi, Adacel

16 year: Medquadfi, Trumenba (Trumenba is not required by highschool but is required for most colleges)

17 year: Trumenba

Influenza vaccine is offered every year during flu season when available and although not required for school attendance, our physicians highly recommend that your child receives this vaccine.

\*Gardasil (HPV vaccine) is a 2 part series if received before the child's 15th birthday, otherwise the child will need 3 doses. We start asking if you would like your child to receive this vaccine at 9 years of age when it is recommended and every year at their physical appt.

Pentacel is a combination vaccine, Dtap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis), Hib (Haemophilus Influenzae Type b), IPV (Polio)

Rotateq is the rotavirus vaccine.

PCV13 is the Pneumococcal Conjugate vaccine.

Varivax is the chicken pox vaccine.

MMR is the measles, mumps, rubella vaccine.

Quadracel is a combination vaccine, Dtap (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) & IPV (Polio)

Proquad is a combination vaccine, Varivax & MMR

Menquadfi is the Meningitis ACYW vaccine.

Trumenba is the Meningitis B vaccine.

Adacel is the Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis) vaccine/booster.
